2014-2015 ASSOCIATION BUDGET

It was moved and seconded to accept the Association Budget as recommended by the Finance Committee. Motion carried. The new Association fee will be \$90.00, an increase of \$10.00 over the previous year's \$80.00 fee. The Finance Committee had originally recommended an increase of \$5.00 over the previous year, but after a lengthy discussion regarding costs of printing the new Building Guide, it was agreed to increase the amount. The Association is obligated to provide each and every owner with a printed Building Guide – at least once. The Guide will also be on the website. After the initial distribution, it was generally agreed that any further responsibility for obtaining copies of the Guide would rest with the owner and could be done electronically
